



INCREASED SERVICE COMING JULY 9

*****WEEKDAY EXPANSION INCLUDES*****

- Added a second bus to the Cambridge and Isanti Area Route -
 - Service will now connect to Isanti Estates, the area east of Highway 65 & routinely to the area both east and west of Long Lake.
 - Service operates Monday – Friday 6am – 5pm.

50% SERVICE INCREASE

- Added a second bus to the Cambridge City Route –
 - Increased service hours will operate from 7:30am – 4:30pm.

- Added a third bus to our Chisago County Area Route –
 - Added hourly service to and from Harris and Rush City to our current route. (Current route includes stops in North Branch, Stacy, Wyoming, Chisago City, Lindstrom and Center City)

30% SERVICE INCREASE

- Added service to residents that live along both County Road 14 & County Road 9.
- Service operates Monday – Friday 6am – 5pm.

******NEW WEEKEND SERVICE******

- Service provided will be the Cambridge and Isanti Area Route, Cambridge City Route and North Branch City Route.
 - Saturday service will operate from 7am – 5pm and will be similar to our weekday service.
 - Sunday service will operate from 7am – 1pm and will have an emphasis on service to and from area churches, shopping and other common area destinations.

Current Service Information

- **History** Began in 1986 in Chisago County, Isanti County was added in 1995
- **Hours** Cambridge and North Branch City Routes operate M - F 8am – 5pm
All other routes operate M – F 6am – 5pm (Cambridge/Isanti Area Route, Chisago County Area Route, North Branch/Pine City Route, Cambridge to North Branch Route, Princeton Route and Cambridge/Braham Route)
- **Base fares** \$.75 (*65 and older in town rides only*)
\$1.50 in town
\$2.00 city to city
\$3.50 transfer
Prices are based on a one-way ride
Exact change, checks, token or pre-paid fare card are acceptable forms of fare payment
- **Vehicles** All buses are wheelchair lift-equipped and the lift can be deployed for any reason
- **Service Type** Curb to curb. We serve the general public. Everyone is welcome to ride the bus
 - Rides must be scheduled at least one day in advance, by 3pm. Rides can be scheduled up to two weeks in advance.
 - We operate with a 10 minute window. Passengers must be ready 10 minutes ahead of pick up time. Passengers can be dropped off between 10 minutes before and up to 10 minutes after their scheduled drop off time.
 - Drivers have a Commercial Driver’s License and are trained in Passenger Assistance, Defensive Driving and Sensitivity training.
- **Staff** 7 office staff, 24 bus drivers, and 1 full time mechanic
